Nearby Attractions

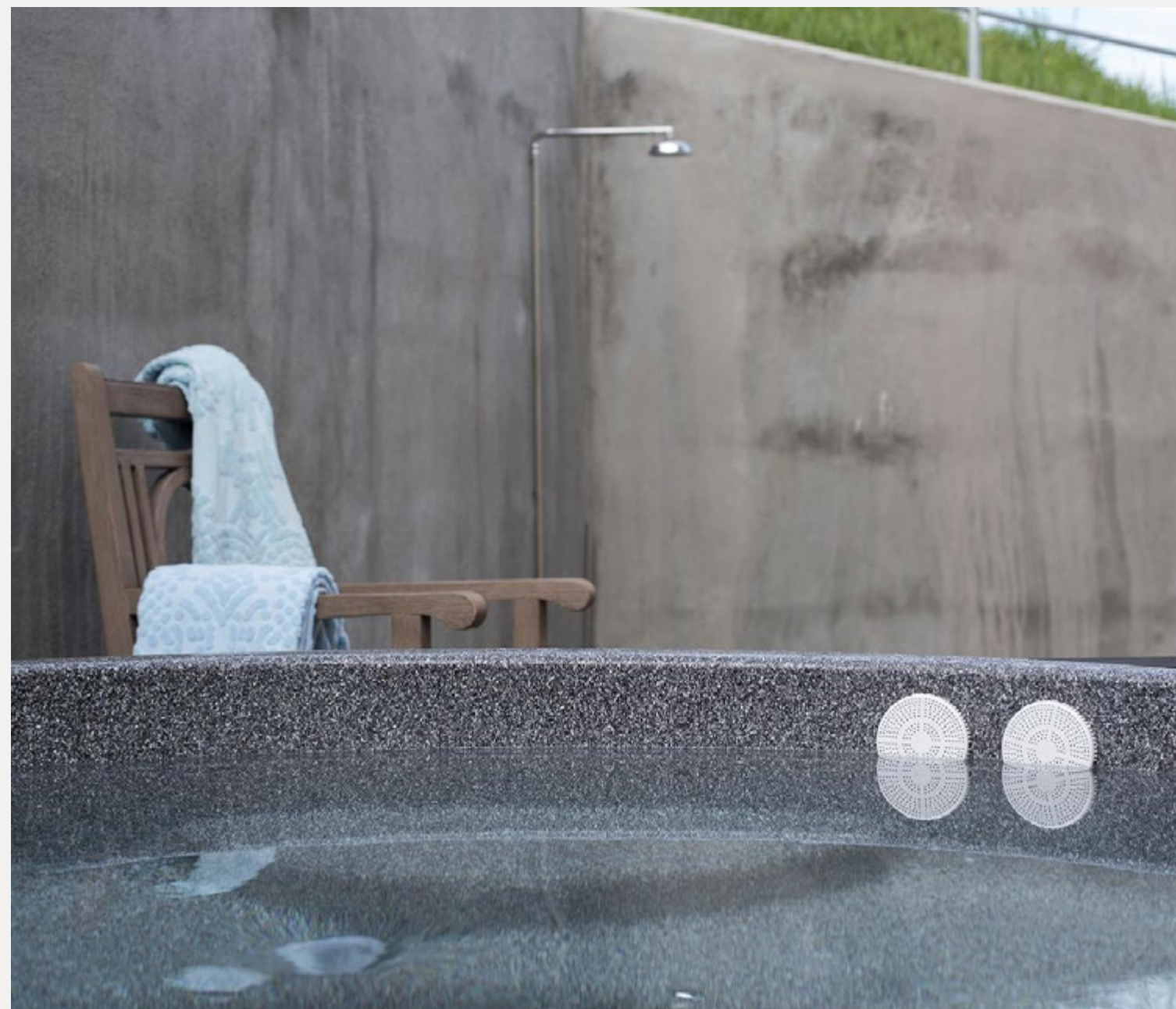
Guests of The Old Apotek are perfectly positioned to explore some of Iceland's most breathtaking natural wonders:

Forest Lagoon – A world-class geothermal spa surrounded by nature, just minutes from Akureyri.

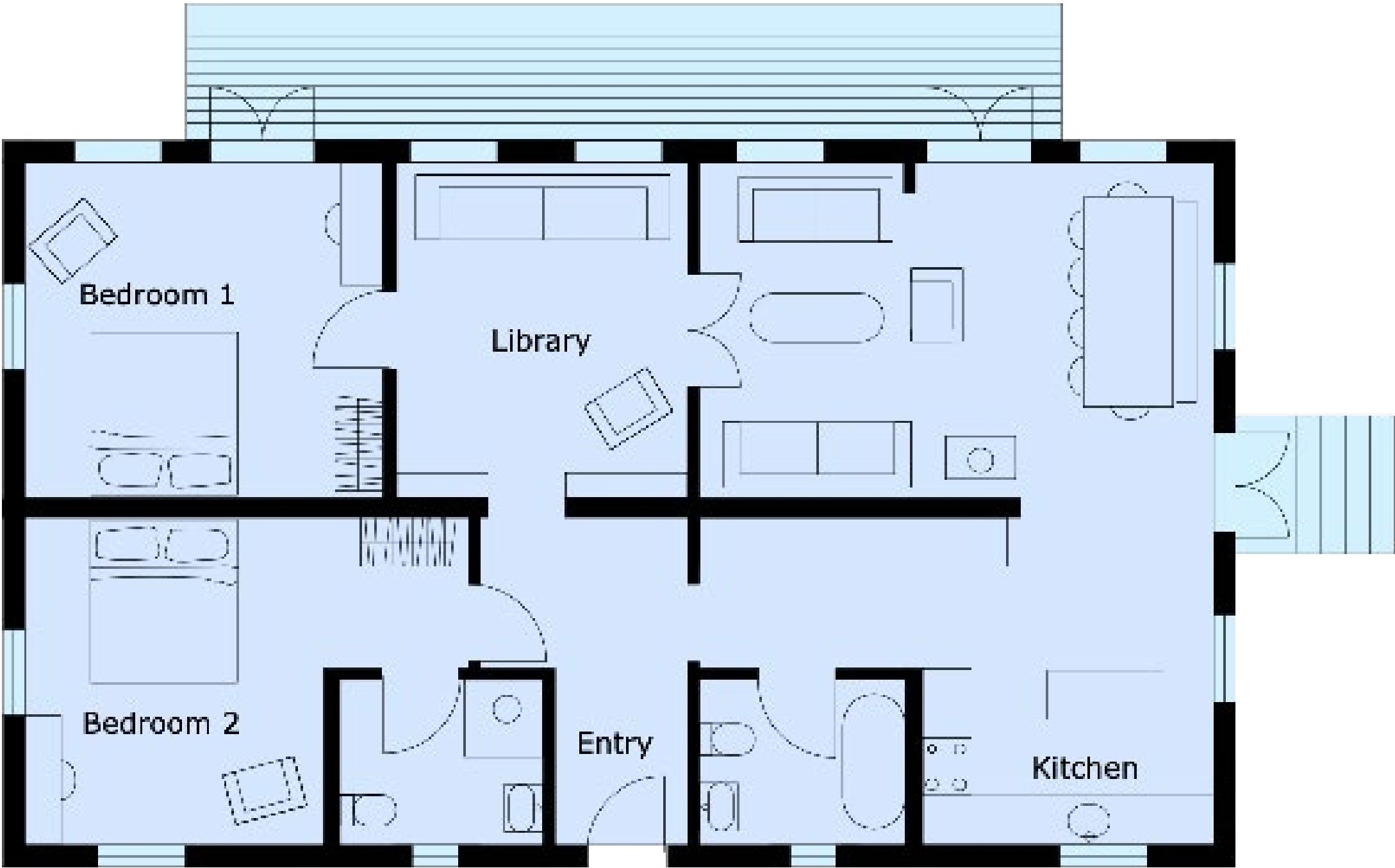
Hlíðarfjall Ski Area – Iceland's top ski destination with incredible slopes and panoramic fjord views.

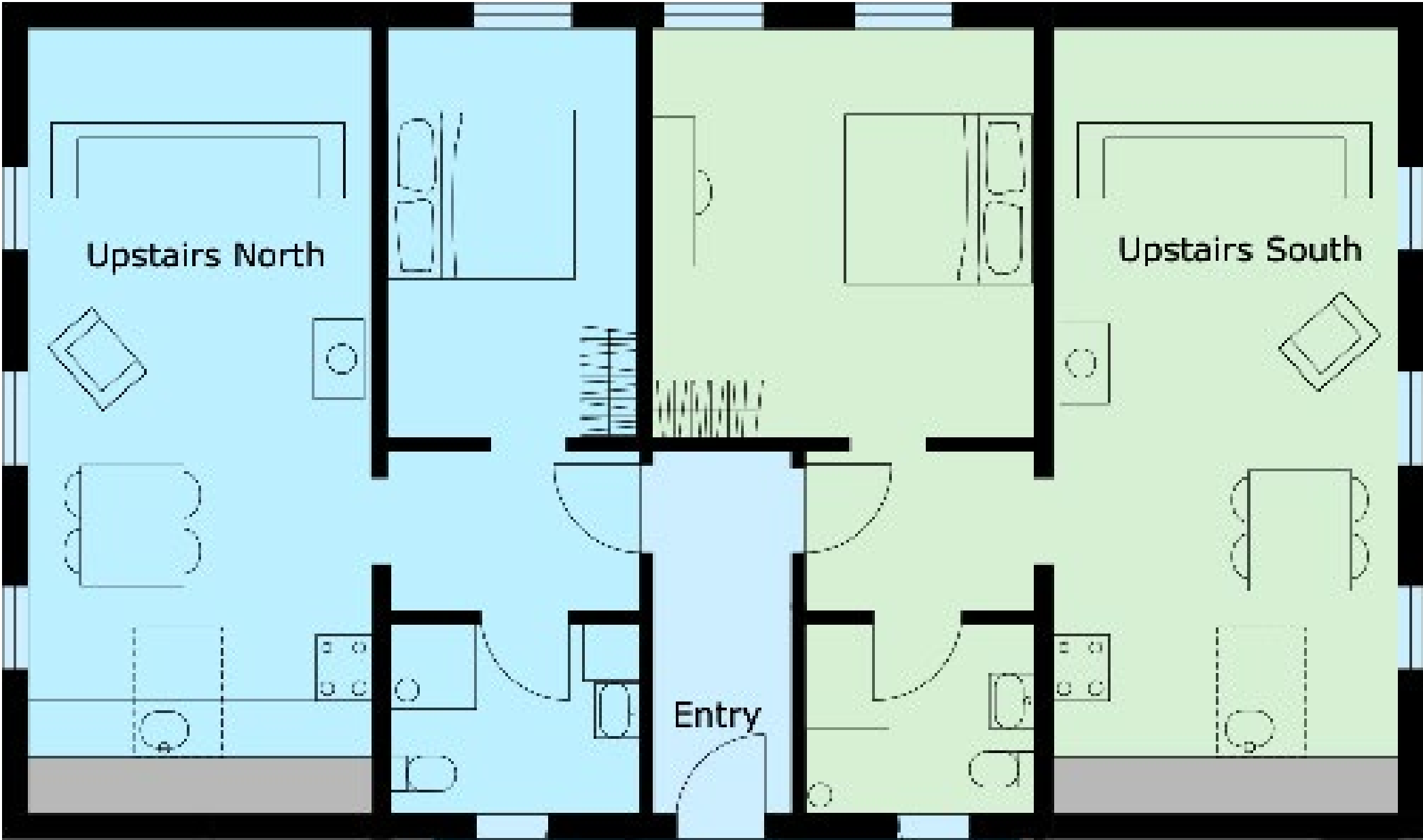




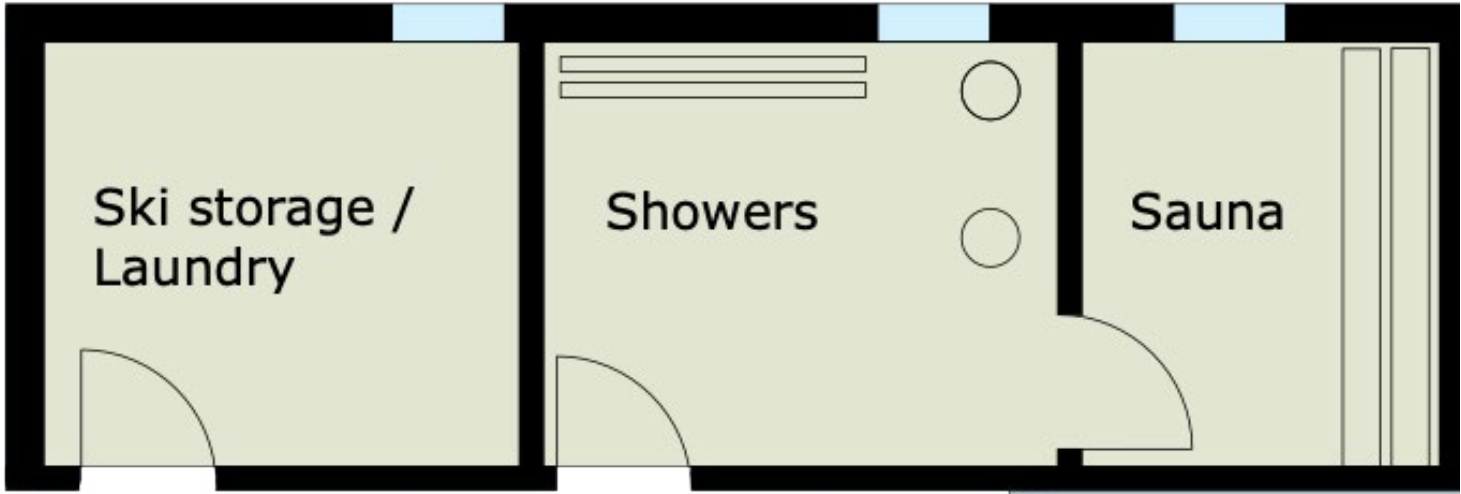
Property Floor Plan
